
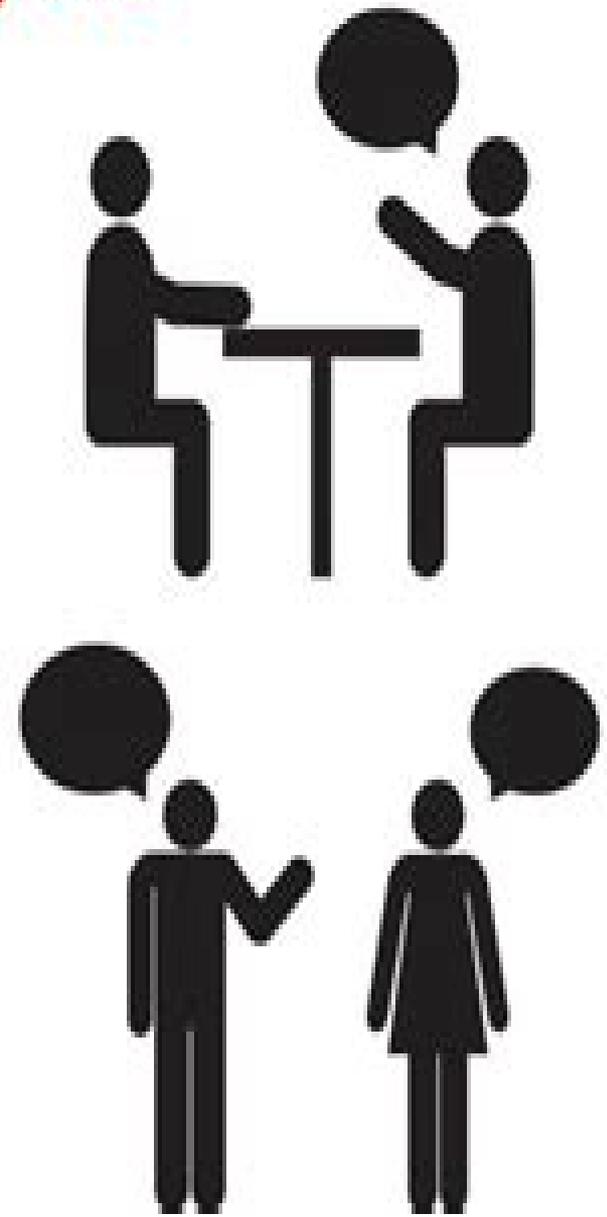

His publications include *Language in Social Groups* (1962), *Ethnography of Communication* (1964), and *Directions in Sociolinguistics* (1972, 2002, both coedited with Dell Hymes), *Discourse Strategies* (1982), *Language and Social Identity* (1982), and *Rethinking Linguistic Relativity* (1996, coedited with Steven Levinson). He is currently working on a collection of studies, *New Ethnographies of Communication*, coedited with Marco Jacquemet, and *Language in Social Theory: Power Talk*.

Joanna Thornborrow, 2014-08-27.
