- Set notation: $\{1, 2, 3\}$, $\{\{1, 2\}, \{3\}, \{1, 2, 3\}\}$, $\{1, 2, 3, \dots\}$, \emptyset , $\{x \in \mathbb{R} \mid -3 < x < 6\}$.
- Set A is called a *subset* of Set B , written as $A \subseteq B$, when $\forall x, x \in A \rightarrow x \in B$.
- A is a *proper subset* of B , when A is a subset of B and $\exists x \in B$ and $x \notin A$.
- Visual representation sets: *Venn diagrams*.
- Note the distinction between \subseteq (set containment) and \in (set membership).
