The Bracero Program Richard B. Craig, 2014-12-19 Long before Cesar Ch vez and Chicano became commonly known the word bracero had established itself in the language of American politics The Mexican Farm Labor Program or bracero program as it came to be known was from its inception in 1942 a highly controversial issue At international national and subnational levels it remained the focal point of an intense interest group struggle This struggle and its group combatants provide the central concern of this study In the early 1940 s agribusiness interests had sought to contract Mexican laborers braceros for work on United States farms With the entry of the United States into World War II legislation was passed for contracting braceros on a large scale What was originally a wartime measure soon became an institution During twenty two years 4 2 million braceros were contracted The United States at the insistence of the Mexican government became a partner in the program ensuring that the braceros were provided housing set wages and other benefits The program was however detrimental to one group in the United States the native farmworker Not only was the bracero provided guarantees that the native could not demand but the bracero also got the native s job During the late forties and fifties organized labor gathered its forces in Congress to oppose the program Finally an administration favorable to the native farmworker threw its support behind the native laborer and through the Department of labor measures were passed that made it less attractive to hire foreign labor In the end the anti bracero forces won out in Congress and defeated extension of the Mexican Farm Labor program At the same time the United States government by setting the working standards for foreign workers brought about an improvement in the working conditions and wages of native farm laborers Besides the conflicts between domestic interests Craig examines the international conflicts and issues involved as well as the international agreements that were the basis of bracero contracting He discusses with perception the program s immediate and long range effects on Mexico His study analyzes and clarifies one of the most controversial domestic and international programs of the twentieth century

After the United States entered World War II, the U.S. government and the Mexican government formed an agreement that allowed Mexican laborers to work on farms in the United States for short periods of time before returning to Mexico. Under this agreement, which extended until 1962, Mexican workers accepted over 4.5 million contracts to work on U.S. agricultural sites and railroads. Labor's Outcasts Andrew J. Hazelton, 2022-09-13

In the mid-twentieth century, corporations consolidated control over agriculture on the backs of Mexican migrant laborers through a guestworker system called the Bracero Program. The National Agricultural Workers Union (NAWU) attempted to organize these workers but met with utter indifference from the AFL-CIO. Andrew J.
