RED WINES



Cabernet Sauvignon
Full-bodied, rich with dark fruit, black currant, plum, oak, and tobacco.
Best from Napa, CA, Chile and Australia.
Pairs well with: beef, lamb.



Shiraz
Full-bodied, spicy with blackberry, plum, and notes of leather, tobacco, and pepper.
Best from Napa, CA, Chile and Australia.
Pairs well with: meat, lamb, well with a variety of foods.



Merlot
Soft, smooth, plump, and full-bodied. Easy to drink.
Best from the U.S. west coast & Australia.
Pairs well with: any red meat.



Pinot Noir
Dry with fruit flavors like cherry & raspberry, earthy.
Best from France, Austria and Oregon.
Pairs well with: salmon, chicken and Japanese.

Wine body and Tannin Level

Four red wine styles are often thrown around, but are seldom explained. **Wine body** defines how the wine feels in your mouth. It's similar to the thickness of the cream of milk. Lighter bodied is very watery, medium bodied is comparable to regular milk, and full bodied is more like cream. **Tannins** are naturally occurring polyphenols found in plants, seeds, fruit skins and other organic matter. Tannins add dryness, bitterness and astringency in the middle of your tongue and the front part of your mouth.

WHITE WINES



Chardonnay
Full-bodied wine from France & Italy in cold climates. Crisp, clean.
Best from Burgundy, France and California.
Pairs well with: seafood, chicken.



Sauvignon Blanc
Light-bodied wine with citrus, green apple and herb notes.
Best from Loire region of France and New Zealand.
Pairs well with: seafood, poultry.



Riesling
Light, clean wine with green apple, pear and citrus notes.
Best from Germany and the East Coast.
Pairs well with: spicy food, poultry.



Pinot Grigio
Dry with fruit flavors of pear and apple with hints of lemon.
Best from Italy, Oregon and California.
Pairs well with: seafood, pasta.

Dry vs. Sweet

Another way wine is described is with dryness or sweetness. Dryness or sweetness depends on the amount of residual sugar left in the wine. Residual sugar is any natural grape sugars that are left after fermentation. The juice of wine grapes starts out with a lot of natural sugar which yeast ferments to create alcohol. If the fermentation process uses up the sugar, it is a **dry wine**. If the fermentation process stops before it uses up all the sugar, there will be more residual sugar, producing a **sweet wine**.

DESSERT WINES



Champagne
Sparkling wine with a crisp, clean taste.
Best from the Champagne region of France.
Pairs well with: fruits, tarts or crumbles.



Moscato
Light and bubbly with notes of apricot and peach.
Best from pretty much anywhere.
Pairs well with: pretty much anything.



Sherry
Dry, light and tangy.
Best from Spain, California and Australia.
Pairs well with: cheese.



Port
Sweet with flavors of dried fruit, baking, nutty.
Best from Douro Valley region of Portugal.
Pairs well with: Game, cheese, fruits.

Why is dessert wine different?

Dessert wine is different from regular wine because of the sugar level and the alcohol level. These levels can be increased in a few different ways. Sometimes grapes are left on the vine longer than they have natural sugar to create alcohol. This and also of course winemakers can add sugar either before or after fermentation. They can also use yeast that has a higher alcohol content killing the remaining yeast. Finally, winemakers can remove water to concentrate the sugar, usually by air drying or freezing the grapes.

GLASS GUIDE



Large Red
Bowl shape lets the wine to breathe.
Best for: Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Merlot.



Small Red
Narrower, directs wine to the nose.
Best for: Shiraz, Zinfandel.



Large White
Smaller than red with a wide bowl.
Best for: Chardonnay, Chablis.



Small White
Narrower still, shape directs the wine.
Best for: Riesling, Pinot Grigio, Sauvignon Blanc.



Flute
Enhances longevity of bubbles.
Best for: Champagne, Sparkling wines.



Dessert
Small, directs wine to back of the mouth.
Best for: Sherry, Port.

LABEL GUIDE

PRODUCER
The winery that produced this wine.

VINTAGE
Indicates which year has a slight difference in taste.

VARIETY
The grape variety, at least 75% of that type of grape.

REGION
The area where the grapes were grown, or better yet, the specific vineyard.

ALCOHOL CONTENT
How bold the wine tastes.
