ownership of the housing stock by income class All in all indexing the tax system of an economy like the U S in 1977 seems to lead to an efficiency gain slightly hurts the lowest income classes and substantially improves the welfare of the highest income groups The simulation results should however be considered tentative due to uncertainty about the values of several parameters and the relatively simple formulations of the determinants of portfolio choice and the U S financial structure
