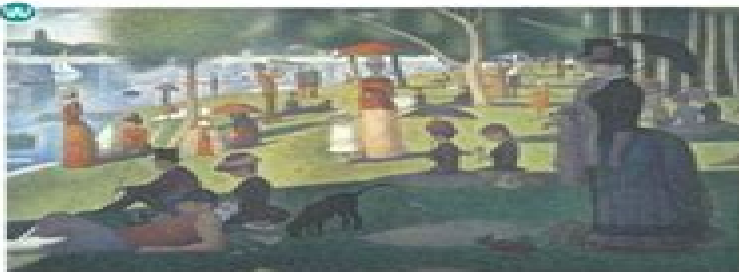


# LIFE IN ART
