The theoretical underpinning of the case formulation will be in accordance with the biopsychosocial model of psychological understanding. Metz (2005) provided a series of key recommendations to the American Psychiatric Association (APA) commission on psychotherapy concerning the definition of the biopsychosocial model, which he comprehensively defined. A biopsychosocial formulation is a tentative working hypothesis developed collaboratively with the child and family which attempts to explain the biological, psychological, and sociocultural factors which have combined to create and maintain the presenting clinical concern and which support the child's best functioning.
