In Part I Searle and Horn examine language use and pragmatics from a philosophical perspective. In Part II the cognitive aspect of pragmatics is represented in the papers of Moeschler, Ruiz de Mendoza Baicchi, and Giora. They focus on well-known domains such as illocutionary constructions, the pragmatics of negation, and the relevance theoretic concept of explicature. However, each paper sheds new light on the familiar concepts. The papers in Part III by Mey, Kecskes, and Grundy discuss the intercultural aspects of pragmatics, while Terkourafi explores the explanatory potential of an interpretation of Grice's Cooperative Principle. Margerie's and Geeraert Kristiansen's articles focus on the application of usage-based methodology in different ways within pragmatics.
